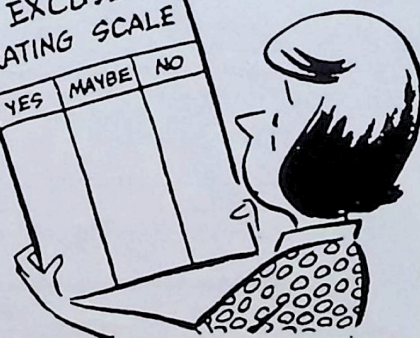

**HOW HAVE WE SERVED GOD IN OUR MISSIONS
IN THE LAST 75 YEARS ?**

Burwood Church of Christ has always been involved actively in the 'work beyond'. Many missions have been held including the *Vawter Mission* (late 1920's), *Tent Missions* (mid 1930's) a series of *Special Revival Messages* (mid 1930's) and an *Evangelical Mission* (1944).

These missions resulted with people in the church being spiritually uplifted and made the plea very well known throughout the district. The local work was encouraged and it was proved to be a time of a spiritual and refreshing revival. In the late 1950's the church appointed an assistant minister and the building was extended to provide for the needs of the rapidly increasing youth work.

Burwood Church of Christ is still supporting many missions to this very day. As a church family we have been supporting the community with the *Emmanuel Project* and *Friendship Centre*. We also have people ministering nationwide and overseas with organisations such as WEC, IUAB, MECO and Wycliffe.
