THE first meeting of the Church of Christ in Burwood was convened on April 18, 1920, when 28 members broke bread in the Council Chambers, Conder Street. On May 2, the Church was formally organised, the first officers being Messrs. L. Rossell, J. Crawford, W. Bugden, E. Childs, A. Stevenson, S. Laney and W. Smith.

In 1921 the Sunday School was commenced under the leadership of Mr. E. Button.

On February 5, 1927, the first portion of the present chapel was erected.

The work of the Women has always been a vital factor throughout the history of the Church.

Ministers who have served include J. R. Leach, W. L. Ewers, R. L. Arnold, D. Wakeley, E. Davis, J. Henderson and A. G. Elliott.
